- Students must be currently enrolled full-time in a health professions education program; faculty must be within 5 years of their initial full-time faculty appointment to be eligible.
- In addition to basic information about the nominee, the application shall include a letter of support, and nominee's curriculum vitae.
 - The letter of support should outline the nominee's demonstrated leadership in interprofessional activities and contribution to enhance the mission of interprofessional practice.
- **Submissions are accepted until close of business on October 21, 2016.**
- Recipients will be notified by email by November 4, 2016.
